Sue Ellen Gallery has just taken delivery of some very special jewellery, antiques and decorative arts, and we are pleased to share a few of them with you.

JUST ARRIVED IN THE GALLERY

- ❖ One-of-a-kind jewels including magnificent diamond pendants, richly coloured cocktail rings, and dramatic onyx and diamond pieces. The gorgeous, handmade "Lily Pad" ring features a diamond-set frog atop a glowing Mexican fire opal, resting on a pave-set tsavorite garnet lily pad, set in 18ct black gold.



- ❖ Fine Chinoiserie Bureau - a Neo-classical Revival writing desk, European, nineteenth century, in satinwood with rosewood banding. Features charming chinoiserie decoration to doors and drop front. The upper cabinet has two shelves, and the drop front reveals a leather writing surface and two drawers. H:132cm W:49cm D:42cm. (Illustrated at left).

- ❖ Magnificent 19th century French clock and candelabra set of hand painted Sevres porcelain on a pale green ground with gilt decoration and ormolu mounts. Each candelabrum holds six candles, and all three pieces feature hand painted cherubs to the front and rural scenes to the rear. The clock movement is by Samuel Marti (France, c.1890). H:56cm (Illustrated below).

- ❖ Additions to our very special, handmade opal jewellery collection, including a magnificent crystal opal and diamond cross set in 18ct yellow gold.
- ❖ "Sirène" and "Kasbah", the new summer collections in sterling silver from Bouvier. Kasbah features cutwork and engraving in a Moroccan inspired design, while Sirène is an elegant spiral design with a satiny, beaten finish and pearl accents.



- ❖ The latest Monteperla designs in rings, earrings and pendants - striking black jade, set with amethyst and citrine.
- ❖ A mini-collection of pretty cocktail rings - delicious little confections of colourful gemstones set in 18ct gold.

- ❖ Just released, limited edition bronze by talented Australian sculptor David Mackay Harrison, whose works are held in private Australian and international collections. "Rebecca" is a three quarter life-size, bronze nude, released in a small edition of 15, thus making her a very desirable investment piece. H:55cm L:105cm. (Illustrated at left).

- ❖ Very elegant French writing table in the style of Louis XV, circa early 1900's. It features exotic hardwoods and fruitwoods, with beautiful floral marquetry. It is of serpentine shape with cabriole legs and ormolu mounts, and incorporates a full width drawer. W:104cm D:67.5cm H: 77.5cm.
- ❖ Eighteenth and nineteenth century sterling silver coffee pots and other investment pieces. All items are English, hallmarked London.
