

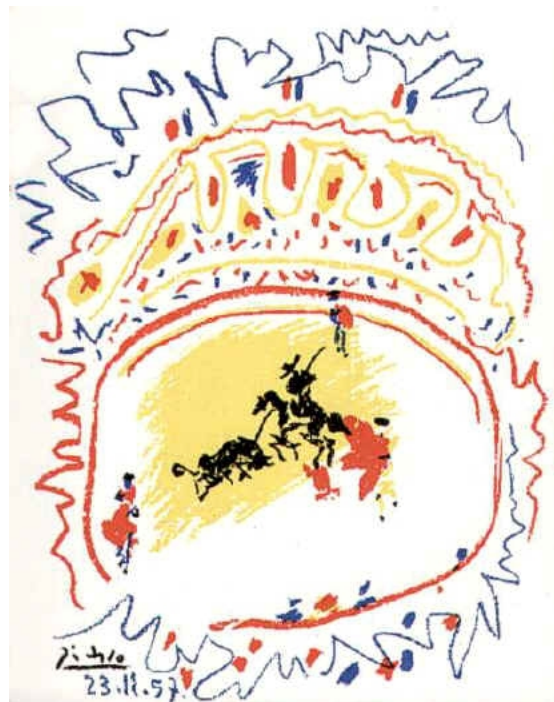
Summer Update 07/08

Just Arrived in the Gallery

- ❖ Magnificent 19th century European carved giltwood mirror and console. The grand dimensions of the giltwood mirror are beautifully balanced by the carved giltwood console with inset marble top. H: 234cm W: 140cm D: 60cm.
- ❖ Beautiful fine jewellery including: a Cartier-style leopard pendant in 18ct yellow and white gold with diamonds and onyx, a stunning 18ct white gold bangle featuring 4.05ct of sparkling diamonds, a selection of luxurious cocktail rings, and cutting-edge Bunz from Germany in platinum, 18ct yellow gold, diamond and gemstones.
- ❖ A small collection of original lithographs and etchings by Pablo Picasso. These works are dated mid-1900's, in mint condition and very collectable. (Illustrated at right: La Petite Corrida, Lithograph, 1957).
- ❖ Very elegant French vitrine table in the style of Louis XV, circa 1860's. In rosewood, featuring a bevelled glass top and ormolu mounts, this display table is perfect for small treasures and collectibles. H: 77cm W: 87cm D: 60cm.
- ❖ A new collection of stunning Baltic Amber jewellery from Poland, set in sterling silver. We also have a small number of pieces in handmade, 14ct yellow gold settings. As always, we have selected artistic and dramatic pieces that will make a statement worn alone or as a set.

- ❖ French Art Deco cold painted figures on marble bases (illustrated at left). The Art Deco style suits both contemporary and classic homes.
- ❖ A mini-collection by young Australian jewellery designer Nadia Neuman. Nadia's contemporary ring designs feature cabochon-cut coloured gemstones, and she also designs outstanding Art Deco inspired pieces.
- ❖ The latest Clio Blue jewellery from Paris in sterling silver. The focus is on dramatic, large-link chains in the fashionable European style, complemented by oversize silver cuffs, bracelets and rings.

- ❖ We have an interesting collection of European porcelain in Art Nouveau and Art Deco styles. (Illustrated at right: Karl Ens porcelain Art Deco Dancer, Germany c.1920's H: 32cm).
